CHSRA Raffle Ticket Guidelines

- All CHSRA members are required to sell Raffle Tickets (\$200 value)
- A minimum of 4 tickets per member are required (\$200 value)
- **The STATE due date for money and ticket stubs is FEBRUARY 1** for both high school and junior high members to THE DISTRICT
- If tickets are lost, damaged, or misplaced, they are just like cash and must be paid for before the member is able to compete.
- If you join after the February 1 deadline (or your district deadline) you will be required to pay the \$200 before you can compete at a rodeo.
- If you join after February 8, you will be required to pay the State directly before membership is completed
- Districts may have an earlier due date, and any member who does not turn in money for tickets will be deemed ineligible to compete in any CHSRA or NHSRA sanctioned rodeo. Districts must submit list to State Secretary of those members ineligible to compete

The grading period must end on or prior to closing entries.

Grades that are not current or have not met the above-mentioned qualifications will not be allowed to check in at the rodeo. NO EXCEPTIONS! This rule will be strictly enforced.

Contestant Qualifications, pg 31, Rule #1

In accordance with the NHSRA rulebook pertaining to contestant qualifications, students who attend a homeschool, private school, religious school or correspondence school are eligible for membership if the school is recognized and approved by the state/province board of education or National Board of Education in the state/province the member is applying for membership. The contestant would need to show proof that the school they are attending is accredited and that they have met the grade requirements.

If the school the student is attending is not accredited by the State or National Board of Education the student shall demonstrate composite grade-level academic proficiency on any State Board or National Board of Education recognized achievement test or other mechanism as provided for in State or National Board of Education rules. A student shall be eligible if they achieve a minimum composite score or survey test score within the average or higher than average range as established by the test service utilized on any nationally-normed test.
