August 14, 2021 State Board Meeting

Student President Brianna Sharp called the meeting to order at 8:33 am.

Adam Boles motioned to approve minutes from the June 10th board meeting. Rocky Steagall seconded. Motion was unanimously approved.

Financials were handed out and discussed. JW motioned to approve financials, Rocky Steagall seconded. Motion was unanimously approved.

Scholarship report will be given in November.

District Policy changes are due to Jen by September 1st, all districts need to submit a digital copy of their by-laws and policies.

State Rodeo Reports:

Junior High: Position of the photographer for goat tying was brought up. More discussion on making sure they are not in the path of the horses. Also, more discussion on the arena that we use. Pros and cons of outdoor vs indoor arenas

High School Finals:

Everyone helped with district responsibilities, and overall, everything went well.

District 9 will need more help with stalling and camping assignments. It is not fair that they are being treated with disrespect

District 1 will need more help with cutting and reined cow horse. With the numbers that we have, it needs to be more than 1 district

Options for parking- Hire outside help to assign parking and stalling, so there are no discrepancies

Comment was made that the ground was inconsistent. --Every effort was made to make sure that the ground was safe for every performance

Personal Motorized vehicles- PROHIBITED In 2022 if you bring a personal motorized vehicle (contestant or family member) contestant will be disqualified. They are prohibited by the fairgrounds, therefore not allowed.

Junior High State Finals: We will open up stock bids and will have a 2 year contract

High School State Finals: JW Brewen will fill Jeff Brazil's Arena director position. John Suther will be taking over Ramona Wold's position in the Reined Cow Horse/Cutting Arenas

Bids will be opened for photographers, announcers and videographers for both High School and Junior High State Finals.

Required bids from National Sponsors: Each district and the state awards need to get bids from Slone Saddles and Gist Silversmith. Make sure that bids are sent to Slone and Gist by January 1st. Please send Jen a copy of the bid request for our files.

District Responsibilities List: Will be re-evaluated and updated

National Director Reports:

ATV tickets: money and stubs returned to Earlene Brooks (in hand) by February. Make sure to send a summary list (members names that turned in tickets and amount they turned in) and 2 checks. One for junior high division (CJHRD) and one for high school (CHSRA)

Lincoln- Facility tried to accommodate. Most likely will not be going back to Lincoln, as the weather is a factor and there was not the room to accommodate the number of contestants.

Junior High National Finals will be in Perry, Georgia--ask membership who will be willing to travel to Georgia

Facilities are hard to find to meet all of the requirements for stalling/camping/indoor arena

State By-Laws and Policies- Discussed with presidents. Clarifications and updates due to technology. Only "change" is adding the verbiage:

If a contestant is determined to be ineligible at the time of the competition, the points earned during that time frame can be revoked. In team events (team roping and ribbon roping) partners points will be revoked as well. Points will automatically be rolled down to the remaining placing contestants

Brandon motioned to appoint Jason Dewey as Junior High Vice President, Tracey Scott seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Board positions will be opening up within the next few years. Joel will be stepping down in 2022, Tracey will be stepping down in 2022, Rocky and Brandon will be stepping down, but Brandon would like to consider the National Director seat.

Open comments:

Discuss with your districts their thoughts on 1 go rodeos versus 2 gos and an aggregate.

Comment was made, High School State finals was larger than we anticipated taking the top 6 in each event, do we consider moving back to top 5?
