### **Saturday, June 10, 2023**

12 – 6:00 pm **Check-in Open** - Shooting contestants must be checked in prior to Roll Call at Bishop Gun Club  
2-5:00 pm **Range is Open for Practice**- Contestants must have vest and back number to practice at the range. If you have any questions on equipment, this is the time to ask

### **Sunday, June 11, 2023**

7:00 am **Light Rifle Check in at Range & Rifle Inspection**- Must have checked in at rodeo grounds and received back number to be eligible to compete  
8:00 am **Mandatory Light Rifle Safety and Ground Rules Meeting** – Bishop Gun Club All shooting contestants must attend. *FAILURE TO REPORT AT Check In WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION*  
Relay #1 will begin immediately following meeting.  
**Light Rifle Competition** – Check for draw prior to event.  
~12:30 pm **Trap Shotgun Safety and Ground Rules Meeting** – Will not begin until completion of Light Rifle.

### **Monday, June 12, 2023**

2:00 pm **Light Rifle Finals Round** – Bishop Gun Club. Top 15 contestants from first round.

#### Important Information

- Any CHSRA member in good standing may enter and compete in the shooting matches.
- Members must enter using the online entry form, as with all other state finals events. Entries close on the same date as all other state finals events, no sign ups will be held at the rodeo.
- Contestant vest and back number must be worn at all times.
- Contestants must provide rifle and ammunition meeting requirements for this competition.
- Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all competitors while on the firing line.
- Any firearms displayed or brandished in public or at the Fairgrounds will result in disqualification from the CHSRA State Finals Rodeo.

  - It is your responsibility to read and understand the rules. Please ask if you need clarification
  - Long sleeve, button up shirt is required as dress code
- Range is located approximately 5 miles from Tri-County Fairgrounds.
- Lunch will be provided by the local chapter of the California Waterfowl Association -No charge, but donations appreciated
- Awards to Top 10 Light Rifle and Trap to be given at Awards Ceremony Saturday at 6:00 pm
- Bishop Gun Club waiver must be uploaded with Grade verification AND original brought to Check in
- Range will be open on Saturday, June 10<sup>th</sup> for practice, 2-5:00 pm
  - Member must wear back number and vest and have a parent or guardian present at all times at the range
- The top 4 placers from the shooting match will be invited to represent California in the national contest at the NHSRA Finals, July 16-22, 2023 in Gillette, WY. Contestants who qualify for the national team must plan to attend the national team meeting on Sunday, June 18, 2023 at 9 am to participate in CA National Team sign up.
