

CALIFORNIA HIGH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCIATION
2022-2023 Membership Instructions

As the new rodeo season is beginning, here is some information that will help you get your membership paperwork in order. **If you still have questions, please contact your district membership secretary.** The National Membership Portal will open for renewals on August 1st. State Paperwork will be available on www.chsra.co on August 1st as well. Your national and state paperwork must be uploaded AT LEAST 3 weeks BEFORE close of entries to ensure you can rodeo. To rodeo in September, your national registration or renewal must be completed (NHSRA dues paid) before August 15th and your state and national paperwork must be completed and uploaded by August 21st.

Returning Members-NATIONAL PAPERWORK

- Update your membership on <https://nhsra.equestevent.com/> If you need your username, contact Jen Fleming (secretarychsra@gmail.com) . **DO NOT CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT, this will delay your membership**
- Once your information is updated, you will need to pay your national dues online with a credit card. Once payment is processed, you will be taken to a page to print off the unsigned forms (national membership application and minor's release). **YOU MUST PRINT OUT THE COMPUTER-GENERATED FORMS-NO HANDWRITTEN NATIONAL FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** There are TWO forms: National Membership Application AND National Minors Release/Waiver
- Make sure that both parents sign both forms. If a parent is deceased or one parent has full/sole custody, that must be indicated on the signature line. The minor's waiver form **MUST BE NOTARIZED**
 - If a signature is missing or not notarized on minor's release, this will delay your membership
- Once your national application and your minor's waiver are signed, you will need to upload them to the membership portal. Make sure to label the documents correctly. Your membership **WILL NOT** be processed until you have uploaded your signed and notarized minor waiver (with notary acknowledgement if used) and signed national membership application on your NHSRA portal.

New Members-NATIONAL PAPERWORK

- Create a profile on <https://nhsra.equestevent.com/> If you are under 13, you will have an additional step: an email will be sent to a parent's email for approval.
- Once you enter your information, you will need to pay your national dues online with a credit card. Once payment is processed, you will be taken to a page to print off the unsigned forms. **YOU MUST PRINT OUT THE COMPUTER-GENERATED FORMS-NO HANDWRITTEN NATIONAL FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** There are TWO forms: National Membership Application AND National Minors Release/Waiver
- Make sure that both parents sign both forms. If a parent is deceased or one parent has full/sole custody, that must be indicated on the signature line. The minor waiver form **MUST BE NOTARIZED**
 - If a signature is missing or not notarized on minor's release, this will delay your membership
- Once your national application and your minor waiver are signed, you will need to upload them to the membership portal. Make sure to label the documents correctly. Your membership **WILL NOT** be processed until you have uploaded your signed and notarized minor waiver (with notary acknowledgement if used) and signed national membership application on your NHSRA portal.

 - California membership application, grading period request form and Home School Verification (if applicable) MUST be signed by the school principal, administrator or counselor.
- State Dues (\$45.00) will be paid online through the link on www.chsra.com. You will not be able to pay this fee until your paperwork is complete and you have received confirmation from your district secretary. You will need to pay this fee before you can enter any rodeos
- Associate membership forms (each member is required to have at least 1, and associate members must be at least 18 years old) and fees need to be completed online, following the link on www.chsra.com

2022-2023 CHSRA GRADING PERIOD REQUEST FORM TO BE FILLED OUT BY SCHOOL OFFICIAL

California High School Rodeo Association requires all members to maintain *BOTH* a 2.0 GPA as of the latest grading period (minimum 5 week) *AND* at least 4 passing subject grades or if less than 4 subjects, must be passing in all with a 2.0 GPA. If these qualifications are not met, you will NOT be allowed to rodeo until the next grading period shows that you have met the qualifications. The grading period must end prior to close of entries.

Grades that are not current or have not met the above stated qualifications will not be allowed to check in at the rodeo. NO EXCEPTIONS! This rule will be strictly enforced. This is a state and national rule.

*Please have your school complete this form so we can monitor your progress and grading periods. **This form gives the CHSRA State Board, district presidents and membership secretaries permission to contact the school to verify grades if there is a question or concern.***

COVID-19 RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the above-named member ("Member") being allowed to participate and compete in the 2022-2023 California High School Rodeo Association (CHSRA) sanctioned events, we, the Member, and the undersigned parent(s) or legal guardian of the Member, on behalf of the Member, and for ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, spouse, parents, siblings, and children, do hereby:

1. RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the California High School Rodeo Association, Inc., all Districts in CHSRA, any other rodeo association, any rodeo committee, any stock contractor, any rodeo or event sponsors and the National High School Rodeo Association, Inc., and each of them and their officers, directors, trustees, managers, agents and employees (all of whom are collectively referred to herein as "Releasees") from any and all liability to the Member, the undersigned, and their personal representatives, assigns, heirs, parents, legal guardians, siblings, and children, and any claims or demands therefore, on account of the Member's or the undersigned's injury, illness, disease or death from the COVID-19 coronavirus, which occurs as a result of the Member's or any of the undersigned's entrance onto the grounds of any sanctioned California High School Rodeo event and/or participation as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in any rodeo event, whether such injury, sickness, disease or death is caused by the negligence or other wrongful conduct of, strict liability or otherwise by, one or more of the Releasees or any contestants, spectators or other individuals at the CHSRA sanctioned facilities.
2. AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from any liability, damage or loss (including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees and other defense costs) one or more of them may suffer or incur arising out of or related to the Member's or any of the undersigned's entry onto the grounds of and sanctioned California High School Rodeo event and/or participation in any rodeo events, whether such claim is based on one or more of the Releasees' negligence, breach of contract or warranty, strict liability or other legal theory.
3. UNDERSTAND that Member's and the undersigned's entry onto the grounds of any and all California High School Rodeo sanctioned events and/or participation in rodeo events during the COVID-19 pandemic contains DANGER AND RISK OF ILLNESS, DISEASE, INJURY OR DEATH TO MEMBER and the undersigned, that COVID-19 is highly contagious, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in COVID-19 which the Member and each of the undersigned appreciate and voluntarily assume because we choose to do so. WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ASSUME AND ACCEPT ALL RISKS inherent in COVID-19.
4. We each agree to comply with all federal, state and local laws and regulations and all security policies and procedures of the hosting rodeo grounds or event centers and the CHSRA relating to COVID-19. We each understand that the Member may be denied entrance to the rodeo grounds and not allowed to participate or continue to participate in the rodeo based on medical check-in requirements and continuing medical requirements during the duration of the rodeo. The undersigned agree that in the event any portion of this document is held to be invalid, the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect to the greatest extent possible under applicable law. The parents or guardian of the Member agree that by signing below they are in addition to binding themselves, binding the Member to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

WE HAVE READ THIS RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT WE HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE, AND INTEND THIS TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY APPLICABLE LAW.

Contestant Qualifications, pg 24, Rule #1

In accordance with the NHSRA rulebook pertaining to contestant qualifications, students who attend a homeschool, private school, religious school or correspondence school are eligible for membership if the school is recognized and approved by the state/province board of education or National Board of Education in the state/province the member is applying for membership. The contestant would need to show proof that the school they are attending is accredited and that they have met the grade requirements.

If the school the student is attending is not accredited by the State or National Board of Education the student shall demonstrate composite grade-level academic proficiency on any State Board or National Board of Education recognized achievement test or other mechanism as provided for in State or National Board of Education rules. A student shall be eligible if they achieve a minimum composite score or survey test score within the average or higher than average range as established by the test service utilized on any nationally-normed test.

2022-2023 CHSRA ATV Raffle Ticket Guidelines

- ALL CHSRA Members are required to sell ATV Raffle Tickets
- 15 tickets are required from both High School and Junior High members (\$150 value)
- Money and stubs must be turned into your district by FEBRUARY 1.
 - Each district may give their members an earlier deadline, so please check with your district
- If your ticket stubs and money are not turned in to your district by February 1st, you will not be eligible to enter in any CHSRA sanctioned rodeos or events (district or state level)
- If your district has an earlier deadline (before February 1st) and you have not turned in your ticket stubs and money, you are ineligible to compete in ANY CHSRA sanctioned rodeo or event.
- You will be ineligible to join the 2023-24 season if you do not turn in your money from this (2022-23) season.
- Each district will have an ATV ticket chairman, who will disburse and collect all tickets and money. Any questions should be directed to your district chairman.
