What is the possibility of awarding saddles for events vs the certificates. Saddles can be 6-12 months out if using the certificates

–This is what the students wanted as they were able to customize and fit the saddle to their seat and their horse

ATV Ticket idea: 2 \$100 tickets versus 15 \$10 tickets, odds of winning are better. Much easier to sell \$10 tickets though

State By-laws and Policy:

Districts can impose a fine, but must be state approved. A cohesive fine schedule can be created so all districts are uniform

John Suther moved to have Reined Cow Horse an optional event (minimum of 3 per rodeo season must be offered) Jason Griffin seconded. Motion approved unanimously

Jason Griffin motioned to have cutting in high school a standard event and saddle bronc steer and bareback steer a standard event in junior high. John Suther seconded. Motion unanimously approved.

Districts voted to have high school breakaway 1 loop and bell collar catch. There was no objections.
